Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50% deeper. This extra space makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads such as backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.

The Quick-Tach can dump things approximately 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket.
