

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capacity, there are actually four sizings of hook type fork carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks may vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the fork. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
